The institute established in 1973 as Vocational Training Institute to create skilled human resources through Technical and Vocational education having acquired land of 3.46 acres. Tangail is about 96 km north of Dhaka the national capital.

In this institute two years Trade course continued up to 1994, with the modernization and reorganization of vocational education system SSC (Vocational) course started in 1995 and HSC (Vocational) course started in 1997. To ensure the social acceptance and dignity of vocational graduates the institute is renamed as Tangail Technical School and College (TSC) in 2003 by a gazette notification from Ministry of Education, Bangladesh. There are 64 Government Technical School and College all over the Bangladesh. The Tangail Govt. TSC is one of the Technical and Vocational Institute which are introducing the JSC(Vocational), SSC (Vocational) and HSC (Vocational) courses under accreditation of Bangladesh Technical Education Board (BTEB). The institute is controlled by the Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Ministry of education, Bangladesh. Trade offering in this institute is Electronics, Computer, Automotive and Electrical.
